1. Pledge to adhere to [ethical photography standards](#).
2. Complete this short [Google Form](#) to provide quotes and your social media handles.
3. Send 1-5 (or more) images/videos to capturecoexistence@projectcoyote.org
4. Focal species should ideally be North American wildlife that are targeted in wildlife killing contests (e.g. coyotes, red and gray foxes, wolves, mountain lions, bobcats, raccoons, squirrels, prairie dogs, crows, etc.)
5. Please label files in the following format before sending: FIRST NAME_LAST NAME_PHOTOGRAPHER/VIDEOGRAPHER_SPECIES_SEASON_LOCATION (state or general area)_CAPTURECOEXISTENCE
6. Sign our Media Release Form, which will be shared once you send photos/videos.
7. Use our #CaptureCoexistence Contributor Toolkit to amplify the campaign and create a more compassionate world for wild lives.
